The Lecturers / teachers shall also shall return the salute. When the teacher enters a class room, the pupils shall rise and remain standing till they are desired to sit or till the teacher takes his seat.
- 3. No student shall not leave the class room without the permission/information of his/her Lecturer /teacher or until the class is dismissed.
- 4. The student not to involve disrupts, or improperly interferes with, the academic, administrative, sporting, social or other activities of the institution, whether in institution or elsewhere.
- 5. The student not to involve violent, indecent, disorderly, threatening or offensive behavior or language (whether expressed orally or in writing, including electronically) whilst on institution premises or engaged in any activity.
- 6. The student not to involve fraud, deceit, deception or dishonesty in relation to the institution or its staff or students.
- 7. The student should not involve any promiscuous activities.
- 8. The students must report on the reopening day after availing term holidays and summer vacation or as instructed by the school authorities.
- 9. Sick students must inform the house parents and Staff Nurse in proper time.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Maintain discipline and time schedule
- 2. Students must respect the elders, teachers and others
- 3. Students must wear uniform and ribbons in pleasant manner
- 4. Students must do their work properly /home work/reading /writing
- To frame self discipline
- House parents and class teachers should motivate the students
- Teachers must inform the disciplinary rules to students and parents
- Using SMS Services to the parents by collecting SMS charges 10/- from each student
- After holidays if student is come late they will pay Rupees 20/- per one day This applicable to the students reporting late after completion of leave
- Sick students must inform the house parents in proper time

- Students must write a letter to the parents before second Sunday
- Students must take gate pass before going to home
