Ref: Review Meeting held with all the Head Office Officials on Health and Sanitation, dt.18.08.2022.

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The attention of all the Regional Coordinators, District Coordinators of TSWREI Society and all the Principals of TSWR Institutions in the state are invited to the subject and reference cited above.

The recent incessant rains and inclement weather have wrecked havoc have caused frequent out breaks of various viral fevers such as dengue, typhoid, malaria, diarrhea etc., in our institutions. Hence, it became inevitable tor everyone to get our campuses clean and neat. It is decided to take up a "Swachh Gurukul" drive in all the institutions for one week, involving all the stakeholders (principals, teachers, students, parents, local public representatives, district officials, head office officials) from 05.09.2022 to 11.09.2022 to spruce up all our institutions.

The detailed document containing the plan of the action, day wise activities and the list of activities to be taken up, cash prizes, sanctioned budget and other details are enclosed for information for taking necessary action. The list of activities is not exhaustive and the Principals & RCOs shall take up the activities based on the field requirement.

Prior to the launch of the program i.e from 05.09.2022, pre-event activities have to be taken up from 2/9/2022 to 4/9/2022 like launching of posters by the District Officials & public representatives, creating awareness

among all Stakeholders of the institution, purchasing the required items as per financial procedures, informing all the students and the staff regarding this programme, planning the activities etc.

Necessary daily report may be sent on the end of the day in the given format.

All the Regional Coordinators of TSWREI Society and Principals of TSWR Institutions are hereby requested to coordinate and conduct the "Swachh Gurukul" Drive i.e., 7 day cleanliness drive and involve all the Stakeholders of the institution and make it a successful program.

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SUGGESTIVE ACTION PLAN FOR ACTIVITIES:

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Principals along with school core group (teachers and student council) are requested to approach the district officials in advance for releasing posters for the Swachh gurukul drive from 1st September to 3rd September.

The principal must give a request letter to the gram panchayat and municipality to send the workers for cleaning of toilets, wash rooms, hand wash areas, water tanks, drainage blockages, drain outlets, water logging areas etc.

The principal can engage 2 workers if it is needed during this drive.

The principal must purchase items based on the need and necessity in advance so that it does not affect the schedule.

DAY 1

All students, stakeholders must take an oath for Swachh gurukul drive and kickoff the programme. The principals have to organize the litter picking programme in the institution premises along with all the stakeholders. Everyone in the school must participate in this programme. Gloves, litter collecting bags and masks must be provided to everyone. All the people who are involved in the litter picking programme must collect the waste and segregate them. These gregated material must be weighed and then disposed off as per the society protocols. Some material can be sent to the recycling centres.

DAY 2

The principals have to organize the cleanliness drive in the school and dormitory building. The students, teaching and non-teaching staff, class 4 employees, plumber cum electrician and principal along with the sweeping and sanitation workers must participate in this programme.

The staff rooms and other special rooms like, principal room, wellness centre, sports room, store room, laboratories etc be cleaned by the respective staff only. The tube lights, fans, TVs, CCTVs, Computers, laptops, street lights must be checked properly and necessary action must be taken.

The class 4 employees, sweeping and sanitation workers and plumber cum electrician must be involved in other works given in the format.

DAY 3

Extensive cleaning of toilets, wash rooms, hand wash areas, water tanks, drainage blockages, drain outlets, water logging areas etc.

The sweeping and sanitation workers, and workers sent by the Municipality and Gram Panchayat must be engaged in the cleaning activity. If there is any need, the principal must engage workers from outside and complete the workin time.

The teaching and the non-teaching staff must monitor these activities and see that they are completed in time.

The subject teachers must organize competitions for the students.

Poster presentations, Slogans writing, Essay writing, Elocution, Wall Paintings. Required materials must be provided to the students who are participating in these competitions.

DAY 4

Parent association consisting of not less than 25 members must participate in the programme. All the non-teaching staff (PD, PET, Librarian, Music, art and craft, ACT, HS), along with the principal, sweeping and sanitation workers, plumber cum electrician must be involved in cleaning the kitchen and the dining area. Students must not be involved in any of the cleaning activities that are done on day 4.


Extensive cleaning of kitchen and dining area. The store rooms, dining area, hand wash area, cooking area, kitchen surroundings and water logging areas must be cleaned.

The rat holes must be properly cemented-especially in kitchen, dormitories and computer lab. The windows panes, tube lights and fly catchers must be properly cleaned. If the kitchen area is dirty and shabby, white washing must be done. The dining area must be well ventilated. Unusable and old furniture must be disposed off.

DAY 5

Green school Drive Day innovative Plantation drive



The principal has to divide all the students among the teaching and the non-teaching staff and form different groups. Each group will select a place in the school campus and plan an innovative plantation model, like hanging garden, medicinal garden, succulent garden etc., The students can adopt a plant/tree, write their names (botanical name and common name) and tag to them. They can even prepare beds for plants, for the water to retain for a longer time. They can also select the trees, big rocks, stones and paint them with lime, colorful paints etc..

Day 6 highlights the creative side of the students by showcasing their talents in various programmes which are directed towards empowering the parents on the importance of the Swachh Gurukul Drive.

The activities include nukkad nataks, dances, songs, flash mobs, poster presentations etc.

Day 8th or day 9th will be the inspection day. An official, nominated by the district collector must visit the institution and check all the areas where the workhas been done and then allot marks, based on the format given below.

The first, second and third best Swachh Gurukul at the state level will be awarded a cash prize of Rs.1,00,000/-, Rs.50,000/- and Rs.25,000/- respectively.

The first, second and third best Swachh Gurukul at District level will be awarded a cash prize of Rs.20,000/-. Rs.15,000/- and Rs.10,000/- respectively.
